2. Regarding fixing of fee, admission criteria and number of seats for NRI candidates in BAMS, BUMS, BHMS & Nursing courses

In compliance of the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 25-8-2004 and the recommendation of the committee constituted by the Government for this purpose, the fees, admission criteria and number of NRI candidate seats, in private Ayurvedic, Unani, Homoeopathic Colleges and Nursing Training Centers are fixed as under. -

1. Seats in NRI quota will be 15% of total intake but out of management quota only.

2. The Fees of NRI's seats in Ayurved College will be 15000 US dollar (Whole course) recoverable in 4 installments as decided by the institutions; where in Homoeopathy/Unani colleges, the fees would be 11,000/- US Dollar recoverable in 4 installments decided by the management of the institutions.

3. The eligibility in admission for NRI seats will be the same as prescribed by Raj. Ayurved University, Jodhpur for other category students.

4. Admission already made will not be disturbed.

5. NRI seats will be filled up from management quota from remaining vacant seats on the following basis -

(i) First preference will be given to those N.R.I. candidates who are having ancestral Rajas than Resident background

(ii) Second preference will be given to those N.R.I. candidates who are having ancestral background of other states of India other than Rajasthan

(iii) Third preference will be given to those Indian candidates who are sponsored by N.R.I and sponsorship letter is attached with the application.

(iv) Fourth preference will be given to those Indian candidates equivalent to U.S.\$ 15,000/- B.A.M.S & 10,000 B.H.M.S/B.U.M.S.

6. Applications against NRI's seats in the Ayurved, Unani & Homoeopathy will be admitted on strictly merit determined on the basis of marks secured in the qualifying examination equivalent to 10+2 level. The institutions are requested to recognize this.



GUIDELINES FOR NRI CANDIDATES

As per directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of Consortium of Deemed Universities in Karnataka (CODEUNIK) & Agr. vs. Union of India & Ors. - W.P. © No. 689/2017 decided on 22.8.2017 (**Annexure 2**) as well as Hon'ble High Court of Rajasthan in S.B.C.W.P. no. 10313/2018 Dr. Sheetal Nepalia vs. State of Raj. & Ors decided on 10.05.2018 (**Annexure 3**) following are the guidelines for the admission in UG Medical/Dental courses under NRI quota:

1. At least one of the parents of students should be an NRI and shall ordinarily be residing abroad as an NRI or
2. The person who sponsors the student for admission should be a first degree relation of the student (i.e. real Brother / real Sister) and should be ordinarily residing abroad as an NRI; or
3. If the student has no parents or near relatives or taken as a ward by some other nearest relative such students also may be considered for admission provided the guardian has bonafide treated the student as a ward. For this following nearest relative (NRI) of candidate can only be considered:
 - i) Real brother and sister of father i.e. real uncle and real aunt.
 - ii) Real brother and sister of mother i.e. real maternal uncle and maternal aunt.
 - iii) Father and mother of father i.e. grandfather and grandmother.
 - iv) Father and mother of mother i.e. maternal grandfather and maternal grandmother.
 - v) First degree-paternal and maternal cousins.
 - vi) Such person should be NRI.
4. Candidate shall submit a proof being sponsor NRI/OCI/PIO in the form of certificate issued by the Indian embassy/Ministry of external affairs, Government of India for this purpose. In the absence of that certificate a duly notarized undertaking executed by the sponsor and notarized by the Notary Public of the foreign country where the sponsor resides being submitted by the sponsor, it be treated as sufficient as to the factum of the residence of the sponsor.
5. An affidavit from the sponsor that he/she looks after such student and will sponsor the entire course fee of the candidate.
6. Seats remaining vacant in Govt. Societies colleges (Jhalawar, RajMES) / RUHS Medical College after exhausting the NRI students, would be converted into payment seats. And if then payment seats remain vacant, those vacant payment seats would be converted into normal fee seats.
7. Seats remaining vacant in Private Medical colleges after exhausting the NRI students, would be converted into normal fee seats.

ALLOTMENT OF SEATS THROUGH ON-LINE ALLOTMENT PROCESS

Allotment of seats through on-line allotment process of all NEET qualified and registered candidates through NEET 2018 result shall be conducted for all the candidates who appeared
